About Heath Ceramics: Founded in 1948 by artist Edith Heath and her husband Brian, Sausalito, Calif.-based Heath Ceramics is a designer and manufacturer of handcrafted, limited production tableware and architectural tiles. The founders' contribution to the history of California pottery is celebrated in numerous museum permanent collections, including MOMA in New York.

In 2003, the company welcomed new owners Catherine Bailey and Robin Petravic. Today, Heath Ceramics enjoys continuous production since 1948, employing the same production techniques, equipment, and staff, at the original Sausalito factory location. Heath Ceramics opened its first satellite studio-retail location in Los Angeles in fall, 2008, run by partner and local potter Adam Silverman.
